Every year all RCA churches are assessed a set amount for each active member. The funds are used for ministry and to care for the pastors who serve the churches.

Our assessment for 2020 is \$101.17 per active church member. Last year assessment payments totaled \$2,822.00 against a total assessment of \$10,355.00 which meant that our church paid the difference of \$7,533.00 from the general fund.

In order to avoid this additional expense to our general fund, all members are encouraged to pay their 2020 assessment.
