This comes to let you know that registration for the March 3-6, 2020 "Listening Hearts Retreat" at the Linwood Spiritual Center, Rhinebeck, NY is now open. The registration fee will be \$285.00 (this includes \$50 non-refundable deposit). This covers the usual three-nights single occupancy lodging and meals beginning with Tuesday lunch through Friday lunch. During the retreat, there will be opportunity, as usual, for meeting with a spiritual director to reflect on God's presence and movement in your life. The joy of our retreats is our shared leadership for our morning and evening worship times. Please let me know if you'd like to volunteer to lead one of those worship times.
